The use of [brackets] indicates something this editor added to the text for clarity or consistency.

The use of (parenthesis) indicates something the originator added to the file for the same reasons, e. g. (Col,ed) was found in the original manuscript to indicate the person was colored.

Users who search the newspaper transcriptions of the day, e.g. *Canal Trade 1878*, will find some variations in spelling. In this revision every effort was made to reconcile the spellings; although not all variations in spellings were reconciled. Nevertheless, this pair of reports is thought to be the most accurate.
